

Height & Display Rules – Island Booths

Definition:

An island booth is 320 square feet or larger with aisles on all four sides.

Use of Space:

An island booth is separated by the width of an aisle from all neighboring exhibits so full use of the booth space is permitted.

Height:

All display fixtures, components including graphics and identification signs are allowed a maximum height of 12ft. Some venues have low ceiling areas so please check the service manual for any notices for booths in a low ceiling location.

Multi-level or Ceilings:

Exhibitors installing a display with a ceiling or second level must meet all building, fire safety and structural integrity regulations.

All booths must adhere to display regulations:

Including ADA, demonstrations, lighting, sound, structural integrity, and storage.
